Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This petition by the wife is for transfer of the
divorce petition filed by the respondent-husband from the
Family Court, Alappuzha (Kerala) to the Family Court at
Delhi.

It is seen that at present both the parties are at

New Delhi. The petitioner is aged 54 years and she is dependent on her daughters. She is unable to travel long distance to Alappuzha to contest the proceedings. In the circumstances, this is a fit case for transfer.

We find that the petitioner has made some allegations regarding threats made by the respondent. It is unnecessary to examine the same as they are not relevant for this petition.

We, accordingly, allow this petition. Civil Suit bearing No. O.P. (IDA) No.386 of 2009 pending in the Family Court, Alappuzha (Kerala) is transferred to the Family Court, Delhi.
