O R D E R

In this petition, prayer has been made for transfer of T.M.S. No. 615 of 2008 which is pending before the Principal Judge, Family Court, Dhanbad within the State of Jharkhand.

The petitioner has sought transfer of the case filed by the respondent on the ground of financial incapacity and difficulty in travelling from Delhi to Jharkhand.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Since, the respondent has not filed counter to controvert the averments contained in the transfer petition, there is every reason to think that due to financial incapacity and difficulty in travelling, the petitioner will not be able to defend her cause in the Court at Dhanbad within the State of Jharkhand.

The transfer petition is accordingly allowed and T.M.S. No. 615 of 2008 titled Angshuman Mukherjee v. Indira

Mukherjee which is pending before the Principal Judge, Family Court, Dhanbad within the State of Jharkhand is transferred to the Court of District Judge, Delhi, who may try the case himself or make over the same to any other Court of competent jurisdiction for being decided in accordance with law.
