O R D E R

This petition has been filed under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure for transfer of F.C.O.P. No.776 of 2011 filed by the respondent, which is pending in the Court of Additional Family Court Judge, City Civil Court at Hyderabad.

The petitioner, who is a resident of Kothrud, Pune (Maharashtra), has sought transfer of aforesaid case mainly on the ground of her inability to travel from Pune to Hyderabad to attend the proceedings of the case filed by the respondent.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the transfer petition is allowed and F.C.O.P.No.776 of 2011 titled "B. Chandra Paul versus N. Vandana Vallam", pending in the Court of Additional Family Court Judge, City Civil Court at Hyderabad (Andhra Pradesh) is transferred to the Family Court at Pune (Maharashtra).

The records be also remitted to the transferee Court forthwith. The parties are directed to appear before the transferee Court on 14.2.2012. Within four weeks from that date, parties would file their written statements. The transferee Court is directed to dispose of the transferred matter within a period of nine months from the date of communication of copy of this order and receipt of the records of the case.
