There is a delay of 516 days in filing  
SLP and delay of 326 days in re-filing SLP.            We  
find no satisfactory explanation for the delay  
in filing the SLP or re-filing the SLP.            It is  
hoped that the Union of India will take more

avoided.    Be that as it may.

We find that similar SLPs have already  
been dismissed.    We, therefore, dismiss these  
special leave petitions on the ground of delay
