Heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

The petitioner has been given permission to start new Dental
college at Dehradun for the academic year 2006-2007 with a capacity of

50 students. In fact the petitioner had applied for 100 seats and it is claimed that the college has got the full infrastructure facilities to take admission of 100 students. Counsel for the petitioner points out that DCI and the Union of India had declined to give permission to intake 100 students on the ground that one appointee as Reader in the department of Prosthodontics was not acceptable to the authorities as he is hailing from Karnataka. He left the institution and joined other institution at NOIDA and that college was granted permission to have capacity of 100

students. Learned counsel for the petitioner thus, prays that petitioner may also be allowed the intake 100 students. The petitioner would be at liberty to bring this fact to the notice of DCI and urge for increasing the strength for the academic year 2007-2008.
