Leave granted.

This appeal is directed against the judgment and order dated 12.07.2011 passed by the Bombay High Court.

We have heard the learned counsel appearing for the parties. During the course of hearing, counsel appearing for the respondent no. 1 has very fairly stated that the respondent no. 1 would be withdrawing the demand notice dated 03.11.2010 and would issue a show cause notice to the appellant herein to show cause as to why octroi duty and penalty, if any, would not be levied on the appellant in accordance with law.

We accept the aforesaid statement made by the respondent no.1. The demand notice which is impugned herein

shall be withdrawn immediately. We give liberty to the respondent no. 1 to issue a show cause notice within a week from today giving the appellant two weeks time to file their reply to the said notice. In case the reply is filed within two weeks, as stated hereinbefore, a personal hearing shall also be given to the appellant immediately thereafter. It

shall thereafter be open to the respondent no. 1 to pass an order in accordance with law.

Leave granted.

The appeal is disposed of in terms of the signed order.
