O R D E R

This Contempt Petition arises out of the order passed by this Court on 6th April, 2009, by which the the petitioner has been directed to hand over the vacant possession of the suit property to the respondents in the Special Leave Petition, within 31st July, 2009,.

Admittedly, the said direction was not complied with and the instant application is for extension of time to vacate the suit premises. On 30th November, 2009, when the matter was taken up, the premises had still not been vacated, and, accordingly, we issued notice on the Contempt Petition and dismissed the application for extension of time with costs of Rs. One lakh.

Today, when the matter is taken up, it is submitted on behalf of the alleged contemnors that possession has since been handed over to the petitioner in the Contempt Petition, which fact is admitted on behalf of the petitioner. In addition, a cheque for Rs. one lakh issued on behalf of the

alleged contemnors drawn by H.D.F.C. Bank dated 25th February, 2010, towards the costs has also been handed over to the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner in the Contempt Petition.

Having regard to the above, we are inclined to drop the Contempt Proceedings and treat the matter as closed.
