ORDER

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the plaintiff had also put up construction in the margin space of his premises and therefore he cannot have any grievance against the construction in his property. The High Court has rightly observed that if the plaintiff has violated any Municipal bye-laws or regulations it is open to the first defendant (petitioner herein) to take action, as has been done by the plaintiff.
