to their contentions, that as in the case of
SLP(C)...CC 15176/2010

Vaishali Mihir Shah vs. Aakash Lavlesh Leisure
Pvt. Ltd. and another (vide order dated
30.11.2009 in Appeal No.230 of 2009 on the file
of the High Court), the three petitioners are
also willing unconditionally to withdraw all

the complaints against the office bearers of the club, pay all arrears of subscription with interest, and strictly abide by the rules and regulations of the club.
