UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 30.03.2026 in CRMM No.9638/2026 (O&M) titled "*Hardial Singh vs. State of Punjab*" passed by the High Court of Punjab & Haryana at Chandigarh.
2. Issue notice, returnable on 13.07.2026.
3. Ms. Nupur Kumar, learned Advocate-on-Record, accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. Hence, the formal

service of notice on the respondent-State is waived.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner to serve a copy of the present petition to the learned counsel for the respondent-State within a period of one week.

5. Let counter affidavit be filed within two weeks. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within one week thereafter.

6. In the event of arrest in connection with F.I.R. No.9/2026 dated 09.01.2026, registered at P.S .Ranjit Avenue, District-Amritsar, the petitioner shall be released on bail by the Investigating/Arresting Officer on such terms and conditions as imposed and found to be just, fair and reasonable.

7. However, in the attending facts, one of the conditions shall necessarily be that if the petitioner possesses a Passport, the same shall be deposited before the Competent Authority/Court, until the conclusion of the Trial or unless directed otherwise.

8. The petitioner shall make himself available before the Investigating Officer on 14.05.2026 at 10:00 a.m. and on all such dates as he may be required.

9. Needless to add, the petitioner would maintain good conduct and not attempt to influence any of the witnesses, in any manner, till the completion of the trial.
