The apprehension of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that even though in the first part of the order it is provided that the payment factor should be notionally added to the pension, meaning thereby that the actual payment would not be made. But in the latter part of the order it is observed that if on the basis of the computation, as indicated in the earlier part, the arrears, if any, would become payable within six months. It is submitted that in view of the ambiguous order as passed, the liability of arrears may be fastened upon the petitioners. Let a limited notice be issued to the extent as indicated above.
