O R D E R

1. The petitioners challenge the impugned judgment and order dated 25.06.2025 in WP No.12340/2025, passed by the High Court of Telangana at Hyderabad.
2. Delay condoned.

3. We have heard learned senior counsel/counsel(s) appearing for the petitioner(s).
4. The petitioners are aggrieved only with that part of the judgment whereby notional salary has been awarded for the period from 14.06.2013 till 01.07.2025.
5. Issue notice confined only to the aforesaid grievance, returnable on 31.07.2026.
6. Dasti service, in addition, is permitted. Let steps for service be taken within one (01) week.
7. Mr. G. Pramod, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1/the Government of Andhra Pradesh and Ms. Devina Sehgal, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.2/the State of Telangana. Hence, the formal service of notice on the respondent nos.1 and 2 is waived.
8. The petitioners to serve a copy of the present petition to the learned counsel for respondent nos.1 and 2 immediately.
9. Let counter affidavit be filed within four (04) weeks. Rejoinder affidavit thereto, if any, be filed before the next date of listing.
10. In the notice itself, let it be mentioned that respondents are required to file their counter affidavit and reply to the interlocutory application(s), if any, before the next date of listing.
