UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 30.03.2026 in CRM-M No.16869 of 2026, titled "*Joginder Singh Vs. State of Haryana*", passed by the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh.
2. We have heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. Issue notice, returnable on 14.07.2026.
4. Dasti service, in addition, is permitted. Let steps for service be taken within one (01) week.
5. Mr. Samar Vijay Singh, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of respondent/State. Hence, the formal service of notice on the respondent is waived.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner to serve a copy of the present petition to learned counsel for respondent

forthwith.

7. Let counter affidavit be filed within three (03) weeks. Rejoinder affidavit thereto, if any, be filed before the next date of listing.

8. We make it clear that no further opportunity will be granted for this purpose.

9. In the event of arrest in connection with FIR No.185 dated 09.08.2024, registered at Police Station - City Nuh, District - Nuh, Haryana, the petitioner shall be released on bail on the appropriate terms and conditions as may be fixed by the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. However, in the attending facts, one of the conditions shall necessarily be that if the petitioner possesses a passport, the same shall be deposited before the Competent Authority/Court, till the conclusion of the Trial or directed otherwise.

10. The petitioner shall make himself available before the Investigating Officer on 22.05.2026 at 10:00 a.m. and on all such dates as he may be required.

11. Needless to add, till the investigation is not complete in all respects, the petitioner would fully cooperate, and if the challan/charge sheet is filed, he would maintain good conduct and not attempt to influence any of the witnesses in any manner till the completion of the trial.
