The grievance of the petitioner is that the complaint filed by him before M.R.T.P.C. has been pending from 2000 and that inspite of his repeated requests the matter is not being taken up and disposed of, though the matter is being listed regularly. He has produced all the order sheets from 2000 to 2009. He has sought a direction to the M.R.T.P.C. to immediately dispose of the matter and also sought a direction to the responding to co-operate for early disposal.

The M.R.T.P.C. is succeeded by the Competition Appellate tribunal. On the facts and circumstances, we are of the view that the petitioner should make a request to the Competition Appellate Tribunal to dispose of the matter without delay having regard to the long pendency of the case. If such a request is made, we are sure that the Tribunal will take up and dispose of the matter without any further delay. With the said observations the writ petition is disposed of.
