UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following  
ORDER

We have heard learned counsel for the petitioner.

In our opinion, the High Court is right in observing as under :

"If the petitioner is aggrieved with conduct of the respondent, and if he wants to pursue the allegations of tampering of the record, he is at liberty to approach the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai. If any complaint in this regard is made to the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai, he may decide the complaint on merits."

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in pursuance of the above observations made by the High Court, a complaint is already made to the Commissioner of Police, Mumbai by the petitioner on September 24, 2008. Let the Commissioner may take appropriate decision as expeditiously as possible.

The special leave petition is, accordingly, disposed of.
