UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioner is the original complainant.
2. The submission on behalf of the petitioner is that High Court had granted bail on the ground that Test Identification Parade was conducted after a month and, therefore, its sanctity becomes doubtful. Besides, the High Court observed that after carrying out Test Identification Parade, no

supplementary statement of the complainant, who happens to be the eye-witness, was recorded to ascertain the exact role played by the respondent.

3. The case of the complainant is that if the investigating agency did not record the supplementary statement of the complainant, it is the fault on the part of the investigating agency.

4. Insofar as the present case is concerned, it is a case of brutal murder where multiple stab wounds were caused to the deceased and since the accused were not known at the time of lodging the First Information Report, the First Information Report was lodged against unknown persons but once the accused were identified, they had to be treated as accused of a heinous crime.

5. In such circumstances, it is prayed that the order granting bail should be set-aside.

6. Issue notice, returnable in six weeks.
