O R D E R

1. In the course of the arguments, the learned counsel for the petitioner(s) has placed reliance on the submissions made on behalf of the appellant as noted in paragraph 4 of the impugned order so

as to contend that once the defendant had admitted the plaintiff's title in proceeding under Section 70B of the Tenancy Act, he was estopped from questioning the title of the plaintiff in view of Section 116 of the Indian Evidence Act, 1872.

2. It is not clear from the materials available on record whether said document on which reliance has been placed is part of the record of the Trial Court proceedings.

3. In the above context, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) prays for and is allowed two weeks' time to seek instructions and file affidavit indicating whether the document on which reliance was placed before the Second Appellate Court was brought as additional evidence or was part of the record of the suit proceedings.
