UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Delay condoned.
2. It is argued that the deceased Mohan Singh and his wife Jyoti Singh had obtained loan from the petitioner and for repayment of the loan, they had issue separate cheques, which were dishonoured, for which complaint under Section 138, Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 was initiated against both of them and on 22.03.2024, wife of the deceased Jyoti

Singh was convicted and in the complaint case against the deceased, his statement under Section 313 of The Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 was recorded, however, he committed suicide on 06.03.2024. Thereafter, the present FIR was registered on 14.04.2024 alleging that because of the threat extended by the petitioner for repayment of the loan, the deceased committed suicide.

3. Issue notice, returnable on 16.11.2026.

4. In the meanwhile, further proceedings emanating from FIR No. 0121 of 2024, registered at Police Station Sipri Bazar, District Jhansi, for the offence punishable under Sections 306 and 506 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and 3(2)(v) of The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act (Amendment 2015), shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing.
