O R D E R

1. The original records produced by the Election Commission are taken on record and shall be retained by the Registrar (Judicial). The same shall be produced by him on the next date of hearing.

4. Parties are at liberty to file additional affidavits, if any, by the next date of hearing.
5. The original record in Election Petition No. 20/2023 shall be

called for by the Registry from the High Court of Karnataka.
The Registry shall ensure that the record called for from the
High Court is secured by the next date of hearing.

6. Re-list on 23.07.2026 with the understanding that the matter would be taken up after completion of the hearing in all the other miscellaneous matters.
7. Earlier interim order dated 11.05.2026 shall continue to operate till the next hearing.
