No ground is made out to interfere, in particular, having regard to the following two circumstances : Firstly, the Division Bench of the High Court has clearly stated that if any individual lecturer is not given the benefit of previous service on the ground that he was not holding the post of lecturer lawfully, he shall be at liberty to assail the same in accordance with law. Secondly, the order only states that whatever is illegal cannot be counted. This necessa rily means whatever is regularised and held to be legal cannot be reopened.

In view of the above, the special leave petition is dismissed.
