O R D E R

1. The Petitioner - wife has filed this Petition under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure with the prayer for transfer of Matrimonial Case F.C. (Cvl.) Case No.48 of 2011 titled "Amitva Sengupta versus Mithu Sengupta" pending before the Principal Judge, Family Court at Silchar: Cachar (Assam) to Family Court at Worara in District Chandrapur (Maharashtra).

2. Having gone through the same, we deem it fit and proper to transfer the matter to the Family Court at Worara in District Chandrapur (Maharashtra). The parties are directed to appear before the said Court on 30.4.2012 and the Principal Judge, Family Court at Silchar: Cachar (Assam) is directed to remit the record to the said Court forthwith.

3. In case Petitioner - wife has not filed written statement so far, she may file her Written Statement within fifteen days from the date, she puts in appearance on 30.4.2012. The Court, thereafter, would frame issues and decide the suit itself as expeditiously as possible and preferably within a period of nine (9) months from the date of framing of the Issues. It is also expected that none of the parties would seek undue
