O R D E R

1. Heard Mr. N. Rabindranath Kamath, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Snehasish Mukherjee, learned AOR.
2. Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner submits that the incident is of 2009. Learned Senior Counsel for

the petitioner also submits that petitioner had already undergone about 16 days in custody pursuant to his surrender on 11.05.2026, out of total sentence of 08 months imposed by the Trial Court at Virajpet in C.C.No.1029/2009 for the offences punishable under Sections 279, 337, 338 & 304(A) of the Indian Penal Code, 1860.

3. Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner submits that to compensate the legal representatives of deceased and the three injured persons, he will deposit an amount of Rs.5,00,000/- in this Court.

4. Liberty is given to implead the legal representatives of deceased as well as the three injured persons.

5. Let necessary application be filed for impleading the legal representatives of deceased as well as the injured persons.

6. Let the petitioner also deposit a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- before the Registry of this Court within a period of four weeks from today. Upon deposit, the amount be kept in an interest bearing short term fixed deposit in a Nationalised Bank on auto renewal basis.

7. Issue notice, returnable on 14th August, 2026.

8. Liberty to serve the Standing counsel for the State of Karnataka.

9. Till the next date of hearing, the petitioner is released on interim bail subject to the satisfaction of

the Civil Judge, J.M.F.C. at Virajpet, Karnataka in connection with the aforesaid C.C.No.1029/2009 for the offences mentioned hereinabove.
