The High Court for the reasons recorded in the impugned order rejected the

prayer made by the petitioners to quash the FIR.

We have perused the order impugned in this Special Leave Petition. We see no reason to interfere with the order passed by the High Court.

However, the High Court has permitted the petitioners to apply for bail in

respect of remaining offences under Sections 498A/323/147 I.P.C. and Section 3/4 of

Dowry Prohibition Act and their bail application shall be decided by the court

expeditiously, if possible, on the same day. We ratify the said direction given by the

High Court.

In the meanwhile, Hari Prasad Verma (petitioner No.6), if arrested, shall be

released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial court.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of accordingly.
