The petitioner shall, if it has already not done so, pay
the insurance amount and interest to the respondent along with cost
in terms of the order passed by the District Consumer Disputes
Redressal Forum (for short, 'the District Forum') and the National
Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission (for short, 'the National
Commission'). However, the direction given for recovery of the
cost from the salary of the officers of the petitioner is deleted
because they were not parties to the litigation.

A report showing compliance of the order passed by the
consumer fora including the direction given by the National
Commission for payment of cost shall be filed in the District Forum
within eight weeks. If the District Forum finds that the petitioner
has not complied with this order, then proceedings may be initiated
under Sections 25 and 27 of the Consumer Protection Act, 1986.
