UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The prayer sought for in the present petition is similar and identical to the prayer that was sought in W.P. (C) No.582/2026 which has been disposed of by this Court vide order dated 11.05.2026 whereunder it was observed as follows:

"5. Mr. C U Singh, learned senior counsel appearing for some of the petitioners in the unlisted matter(s) would also hasten to add that some of the Advocates have already submitted representation(s) to the Hon'ble Chief Justice of India in this regard and pray for some being considered favourably.

6. Having regard to the totality of circumstances of the case, we are of the considered view that ends of justice would be met by directing the petitioners to submit a comprehensive and exhaustive representation to the Hon'ble Chief Justice of India and in the event of such a

representation being filed, we see no reason as to why the Hon'ble Chief Justice of India would not consider it sympathetically by taking into consideration all the circumstances prevalent including the grievances addressed in the respective representations that are being filed or already filed. We request the Hon'ble Chief Justice of India to consider the said representation on administrative side."

2. In view of the same, the order that would be passed by the Hon'ble Chief Justice of India by considering the representation would also govern the petitioners in the instant case. Hence, we are not inclined to entertain the present petition. With this observation, Writ Petition stands disposed of.
