UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

This petition is directed against order dated 31.8.2010 by which the Division Bench of the High Court of Madras refused to interfere with the decision taken by the official respondent to shift the burial ground from Revenue Survey No.19.

After arguing the case for some time and realising that the Court is not inclined to interfere with the order under challenge, the learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner made a request that his client may be permitted to withdraw this

special leave petition.

The request of the learned counsel is accepted and the special leave petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

While doing so, we make it clear that the petitioner shall not be entitled to institute any litigation in this matter in any Court within the jurisdiction of Madras High Court.
