UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
ORDER

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.

In this case, the petitioner was convicted for the
offences under Sections 420, 468, 477A and 120-B of the
Indian Penal Code and the maximum sentence of 5 years was

imposed by the trial court under Section 420 IPC upon the
petitioner. Being aggrieved against his conviction and
sentence, the petitioner filed an appeal before the High Court.
The High Court admitted the appeal but the sentence of
imprisonment was not suspended. The petitioner has
remained in custody for about two years and the appeal is not
likely to be heard in immediate future.

Having regard to the totality of the facts and

circumstances of this case, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail, pending appeal, on furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.25,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of Special Judge I, CBI, (AHD Scam), Ranchi, Jharkhand.

The Special Leave Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
