ORDER

SLP(Crl.) No.7534/2008

In this special leave petition, the trial court vide the
judgment and final order dated 14.7.2008 convicted and sentenced

the petitioner to undergo five years R.I. and fine of Rs.25,00,000/-

under Section 120B read with 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 477A

of the IPC and under Section 13(2) read with Section 13(1)(c) and

(d) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, R.I. for five years under

Section 420 IPC, R.I. for five years under Section 467 IPC, R.I. for

five years under Section 468 IPC and R.I. for two years under

Section 471 read with Section 465 IPC.

The sentences were

directed to run concurrently.

SLP(Crl.) No.7548/2008

In this special leave petition, the trial court vide the judgment and final order dated 30.5.2007 convicted and sentenced the petitioner to undergo R.I. for six years and fine of Rs.50,000/- under Section 420 IPC, R.I. for three years and fine of Rs.25,000/- under Section 468 IPC, R.I. for two years and fine of Rs.10,000/- under Section 477A IPC and R.I. for four years and fine of Rs.50,000/- under Section 120B IPC. The sentences were directed to run concurrently.

SLP(Crl.) No.7547/2008

In this special leave petition, the trial court vide the judgment and final order dated 7.12.2007 convicted and sentenced the petitioner to undergo R.I. for six years and fine of Rs.50,000/- under Section 420 IPC, R.I. for two years and fine of Rs.25,000/- under Section 468 IPC, R.I. for two years and fine of Rs.10,000/- under Section 471 IPC and R.I. for four years and fine of Rs.25,000/- under Section 120B IPC. The sentences were directed to run concurrently.

It is stated by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has already undergone about three years of imprisonment. In this view of the matter, we deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs.20,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of trial court. We order accordingly.

The Special Leave Petitions stand disposed of accordingly.
