O R D E RCivil Appeal Nos.5429 & 5430/2012

The office report is that neither the appellant nor the respondents have filed the statement of case. By order dated 1.08.2014 of the Hon'ble Judge in Chamber it has been directed that in view of the amendments incorporated in the Supreme Court Rules, which are going to be made effective from 19.08.2014, it may not be necessary to file the statement of case and list the matter in due course. Taking into consideration the contents of the order dated above, the matter shall be processed for listing before the Hon'ble Court under the rules.

Civil Appeal No.5831/2012
