These petitions are directed against orders dated 25.04.2011 and 19.08.2011 by which the Division Bench of the Punjab and Haryana High Court dismissed the writ petition and review application filed by the petitioners for challenging the acquisition of their land.

We have heard Shri Ranjeet Kumar, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners at some length and perused the record including the map (Annexure P-22) and are satisfied that the orders
