Petitioner's proposal for establishment of a Medical College was rejected. Petitioner filed a writ petition which was disposed of on 24.5.2010 setting aside the order dated 22.10.2009 returning the proposal and permitting the writ petitioner to re-submit the proposal to the Central government within the indicated time frame and with a direction to the Central Government to refer it to MCI within one week and a further direction to MCI to make recommendation within two weeks. The appeal filed by MCI has been allowed by the Division Bench in an intra court appeal and the order of the learned Single Judge was set aside by the impugned judgment dated 24.9.2010.

It is stated that the petitioner has made an application for grant of permission for the academic year 2011-12 and the matter is under process by MCI. Learned counsel for MCI stated that the matter will be considered well in time. Recording the said submission the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.
