O R D E R

1. In view of the order proposed to be passed by us, we dispense with

issuance of notice to the respondents.

2. The special leave petitions are disposed of with the following order:

(i) The contempt proceedings pending before the learned Single Judge shall remain stayed till 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2026.

(ii) Should the petitioners fail to obtain stay of the order(s) under challenge in the pending special appeals within 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2026, this order granting stay of the contempt proceedings shall stand lapsed and the learned Single Judge, seized of the contempt proceedings, shall be free to take the same to its logical conclusion in accordance with law.

(iii) In the event stay is not obtained, pendency of the contempt proceedings shall not preclude the petitioners to purge the contempt by complying with the order(s), of which contempt is alleged, subject to outcome of the special appeals.

3. All points on merits are kept open.

4. Pending interlocutory application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
