These petitions are directed against judgment dated 13.08.2010
of the learned Single Judge of the Delhi High Court whereby he
dismissed two matrimonial appeals preferred by the petitioner
against the order passed by the trial Court on the petitions filed
by her under Section 13(1)(ia) and (ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act,
1955 and Section 25 of that Act respectively.

We have heard Ms.G.Arife @ Arti Sharma, who has appeared in
person, at length and carefully perused the record.

In our view, the concurrent finding recorded by the trial
Court and the High Court that the petitioner has not been able to
prove her conversion from Islam to Hinduism and her marriage with
the respondent under the Hindu Marriage Act do not suffer from any
legal infirmity warranting interference under Article 136 of the
Constitution.

The special leave petitions are accordingly dismissed.

However, keeping in view the fact that the revision petition filed by the petitioner against order dated 13.02.2009 passed by the Metropolitan Magistrate, New Delhi in CC No.163/1B filed by the daughter of the petitioner under Section 125 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is pending, we request the High Court to make an endeavour to dispose of the same on or before 31.01.2011.
