O R D E R

Writ Petition No.1594/2008 as expeditiously as possible,

in any event, within three months from that date. We are
informed that till date the said writ petition has not
been disposed of.

The present special leave petition i.e. S.L.P.(C)
No.28229/2010 is directed against an interim order passed
by the High Court of Judicature at Bombay in Writ
Petition No.1511 of 2010. We are not inclined to
interfere with the same. In the facts and circumstances
of this case, we request the High Court to dispose of
this writ petition (WP No.1511/2010) along with Writ

Petition No.1594/2008 within three months from the date of communication of this order.

We request the Hon'ble Chief Justice of the High Court of Judicature at Bombay to ensure that both these writ petitions are disposed of within three months from the date of communication of this order.

Both the parties are directed to cooperate with the High Court in early disposal of the writ petitions.

This special leave petition is disposed of with the aforementioned observation and direction.
