UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

In its letter dated October 24, 2011 issued by the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board (TNPCB) to the petitioner-company inter alia; one of the directions related to disposal of Phospho Gypsum. According to the directions, the unit is required to dispose of Phospho Gypsum at least 50% more than the monthly generation quantities. The petitioner-company has made a request to the TNPCB on March 10, 2012 to reduce the Phospho Gypsum disposal to 10-20% more than the monthly generation quantities.

Ms. Srikala Gurukrishna Kumar, learned counsel for the TNPCB submits that the above request of the petitioner-company shall be considered and appropriate order shall be passed by the TNPCB within four weeks from today.

Let TNPCB take a decision on the request made by the petitioner-company in its letter dated March 10, 2012 within four weeks from today and submits its report to this Court.

List the matter on May 9, 2012.

Interim order dated October 1, 2010 passed by this Court to continue till then subject to the permission/sanctions by the concerned authorities including the TNPCB and compliance thereof by the petitioner-company.
