This petition is directed against order dated 19.8.2010 passed by the Division Bench of the Allahabad High Court whereby the appeal preferred by the petitioner against the order of injunction passed by the trial Court restraining the petitioner from interfering with the right, title and possession of respondent Nos.4, 5 and 6 over plot No.22-A, Site-4, Industrial Area, Sahibabad (Ghaziabad) was dismissed.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

In our view, the order of injunction passed by the trial Court was based on correct appreciation of the factual matrix of the case and application of legal principles and the High Court did not commit any error by refusing to interfere with the same.
