UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

Ms. Nandita Rao, learned senior counsel
appearing for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner-father has no objection to the release of
the child's passport. However, she raised/expressed a
serious grievance that the details of the travel of
the child are not disclosed by the respondent-mother
before the Bombay High Court in the application

seeking release of the passport.

She further submitted that appropriate directions be issued to the respondent-mother to provide/furnish travel details of the child to any proposed foreign travel by filing an appropriate affidavit before the High Court. It is stated that the next date fixed before the High Court is 15th June, 2026.

Having considered the submissions advanced by learned senior counsel, the petitioner is given liberty to seek appropriate directions before the High Court as may be deemed necessary and that the High Court may consider the request made by the petitioner, in accordance to law.

The special leave petition and pending application(s) shall stand disposed of accordingly.
