1. In these petitions, prayer has been made for review of order dated 29.03.2010 passed in S.L.P.(C)Nos.10415 & 10416 OF 2010.

2. The petitioners have also filed applications for condonation of 159 days' delay in filing the review petitions. We have perused the averments contained in the applications for condonation of delay and are convinced that the explanation given by the petitioners is wholly unsatisfactory. Therefore, the applications for condonation of delay are liable to be dismissed and the review petitions are liable to be dismissed as barred by time.

3. Even otherwise, after having gone through the review petitions and the record of the special leave petitions we do not find any justification to review order dated 29.03.2010. The review petitions are accordingly dismissed as barred by time and also on merits.
