UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner is that the trial court acquitted the petitioner upon finding that the cheque was not in respect of a legally enforceable debt as the same was time barred.

2. The Appellate Court reversed the acquittal.

3. Against the order of the Appellate Court, the appellant has preferred an appeal before the High Court which is pending.

4. The grievance of the petitioner is that High Court has directed deposit of 50% of the fine / compensation even though the facts of the case did not warrant deposit and, in any case, deposit ought not to have been higher than 20%.

3. Issue notice, returnable in eight weeks.

4. In the meantime, the petitioner shall deposit 20% cent of the fine / compensation in place of 50% as directed by the High Court.

5. Such amount may be deposited in the Registry of the High Court by 30.06.2026. The same shall abide the result of this petition.
