 - (ii) number of witnesses proposed to be examined by the prosecution;
 - (iii) whether charge is framed or not;
 - (iv) if the charge has not been framed, the reason therefor;
 - (v) if the trial has commenced, the number of witnesses examined;
 - (vi) criminal antecedents of the petitioner;
 - (vii) whether any co-accused is enlarged on bail; and
 - (viii) any other information relevant for a decision on the special leave petition.
5. Rejoinder thereto, if any be filed within two weeks thereafter.
