ORDER

Keeping in view the nature of the order passed by the High Court, we are not inclined to interfere therewith. However, as the High Court itself has directed the Excise authorities to explore the possibility of shifting the business premises of the petitioner, it will be open to the petitioner to appropriate application therefor. If such an application is filed, we are sure that the authorities concerned shall take

decision thereupon as expeditiously as possible and in accordance with law, keeping in view the fact that the petitioner's licence is valid only up to 31 st March, 2009.
