UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following

ORDER

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and some of the respondents who are on caveat, we are not inclined to entertain the Special Leave Petition which arises out of the writ petition in which prayer has been made for issuance of Letter of Intent in favour of Slum Rehabilitation Authority, respondent No.1.
