ORDER

Delay condoned.

This Review Petition has been filed seeking review of this Court's order dated 11th August, 2009 disposing of the appeal by directing to pay another sum of Rs.1,00,000/-(rupees one lakh only) on account of medical reimbursement in addition to a sum of Rs.95,000/- (rupees ninety five thousand) which was directed to be paid by way of interim measure.

One of the points taken for claiming review of the aforesaid order is that the workmen of the petitioner-Corporation working in factories are demanding similar benefits of medical reimbursement as has been given to the respondent herein as per 1988 Rules by claiming that the Allahabad High Court settled the law on the point. We reiterate that while disposing of the appeal, the question of law was kept open by this Court. Hence, we do not find any error apparent on the face of the record which calls for review
