UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

At the very outset the learned senior counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that the prayer in the suit was for conducting the elections for the year 2007-2008 and since this long period has passed the suit had become redundant. He accordingly prays that the present transposition order passed by the Courts below was not justified, inter alia, on this ground as well. We are not inclined to interfere in the impugned order as it pertains to a transposition and as it is an interlocutory order. The petitioner may, however, raise the question of redundancy of the suit before the trial Court so that appropriate orders can be passed.

The special leave petitions are dismissed with the above observations.
