ORDER

Delay condoned.

We have heard Mr. Anand Swaroop Mittal party in person. The order impugned against which the petitioner has approached this Court was of transfer from Delhi to Delhi in 1988. The High Court dismissed the petition. We find no infirmity in the order passed by the High Court. Hence, no interference is called for under Article 136 of the Constitution of India. The special leave petition is dismissed.

:2:

The petitioner, party in person, also stated that during the pendency of the proceedings before the High Court, an action of punitive termination has been taken by the authorities and he has challenged the said action. We express no opinion. As and when the matter comes before the Education Tribunal, an appropriate order will be passed by the Tribunal and the order passed by this Court will not come in the way. It is open to the petitioner to raise all

contentions including the contention that the action taken by the authorities is illegal and he is entitled to benefits claimed by him.

The petitioner has also stated that he will be reaching the age of superannuation in near future. We may observe that the Education Tribunal will give priority and dispose of the matter as expeditiously as possible.
