Leave granted.

This appeal is directed against the final order dated 12th November, 2008, passed by the Madurai Bench of the Madras High Court, in Criminal Original petition (MD) No.10380/08, rejecting the appellant's prayer for grant of anticipatory bail. On 12th December, 2009, while issuing notice on the Special Leave Petition, we had noticed a submission made on behalf of the appellant that he was out of the country at the point of time when the incident had occurred. We had accordingly also directed that he should not be arrested in connection with the case till the disposal of the Special Leave Petition.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, we dispose of the appeal by directing the appellant to appear before the Trial Court on 25th October, 2010, and thereafter to pray for regular bail which is to

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be considered by the Trial Court on its own merits, as expeditiously as possible.
