O R D E R

SLP(C) No.21763/2006:

Learned Solicitor General appearing on behalf of the appellants states that the State of Maharashtra is reconsidering the amendment, namely, the Maharashtra Animal Preservation (Amendment) Bill, 1995. In that view of the matter, in our opinion, it would be proper for the State to file an appropriate application before the High Court. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, we would request the High Court to dispose of the matter within two weeks from the date of filing such application.
