O R D E R

1. In this petition the petitioner has prayed for transfer of the petition filed by the respondent under Sections 12 and 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 which is pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Surat

(Gujarat).

2. The petitioner, who is a resident of Nagpur (Maharashtra), has sought transfer of the petition mainly on the grounds of her financial incapacity and difficulty in travelling from Nagpur to Surat for the purpose of attending the proceedings of the case filed by the respondent.
