This matter was taken up at the Supreme Court Lok Adalat with the consent and agreement through their counsel.

Petitioner Sarita Singh and her counsel is present. The respondent Rajeshwar Singh and his counsel Ms. V. Mohana (to be assigned by the Supreme Court Legal Services Committee) are present. The parties held detailed negotiations with the assistance of two learned mediators Mr. K.Venkatraman and Ms. Neelam Rathore.

Parties have following three pending litigations:

- (i) criminal complaint under Section 498A CrPC by the petitioner-wife;
- (ii) criminal complaint under Section 125 CrPC by the petitioner-wife;
- (iii) a petition for restitution of conjugal rights under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act by the respondent-husband.

The parties have settled the entire dispute in terms of the paras (H) to (N) of the 'Settlement Agreement' signed by them and annexed herewith as Annexure 'A'. In terms of the said settlement agreement, both the parties agree to withdraw their respective proceedings initiated by them. The petitioner-wife acknowledges receipt of Rs.1,10,000/- (rupees one lakh ten thousands only) towards full and final settlement of her claim for maintenance and she confirms that she has no other claim pending in regard to future maintenance against the husband.

Both the parties also agree to file a petition under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act for divorce by mutual consent.

Aforesaid settlement is recorded.

Place the matter before the Court next week for formal disposal.
