UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. The petitioners were found ineligible for appointment on the post of Female Multipurpose Health Worker (Axillary Nursing Midwife- ANM) on the ground that they had 18 months training course to their credit instead of prescribed 24 months course.
2. The contention on behalf of the petitioners is that Indian Nursing Council ("INC") introduced 24 months nursing course in the year 2012 but the training institutes in the State of Madhya Pradesh continued to provide training course of 18 months.
3. The grievance of the petitioners is that

because of the State not conforming to the standards prescribed by INC, the petitioners have been found ineligible.

4. Having regard to the peculiar facts of the present case, we deem it appropriate to require the State of Madhya Pradesh to explore providing a bridge training course to all those candidates who were provided 18 months training course despite INC prescribing 2 years training course.

5. The learned counsel representing the State of Madhya Pradesh prays for and is allowed six weeks' time to seek instructions on the above aspect.

6. List these matters on 14.07.2026.
